Celebrate history with the 81st annual Fish Broil and Mullet Festival

In the 1930's, St. Pete Beach and the local school (on Pass-A-Grille) were struggling through the Great Depression.

To raise money for the children's education at The Sunshine school (predecessor to Gulf Beaches Elementary School), Capt. Kenneth B. Merry and his wife founded a community-wide fundraiser, The Fish Broil and Mullet Festival.



In those dire times, an outdoor grille was made of an open fire pit and bedsprings to serve the community.

The alumni, family and staff at the Sunshine school & Gulf Beaches Elementary school kept the tradition alive with a festival of mullet and family activities.
